PLASMA TRANSFUSION TO DEFEAT **CORONA IN INDIA**

We all know that COVID-19 is a very serious problem for the whole world and as the vaccine of COVID-19 is a long way off, US doctors have found another way to fight against coronavirus. This process is known as plasma transfusion therapy. US Food and Drug Administration(FDI) have already approved this process to treat critical COVID-19 patients. Indian Council of Medical Research(IC-MR) has also approved this therapy on 13th April 2020.

Let me explain the process and how it works:

Plasma transfusion therapy is a process in which blood samples of patients who have recovered from COVID-19 are collected for better treatment. When a corona patient recovers, they gain significant neutralising antibodies which helps in recovery of other corona patients. Now the antibodies will be injected into them. This process was also used to treat the pandmic like H1N1 influenza(2009), SARS-CoV-1 epidemic(2003) and also MERS-CoV epidemic(2012). Challenges for this therapy are the blood donation rules.



Prime minister had previously announced the requirement of e-passes for emergency move during this period. The app will also advise people to undergo quarantine or home isolation in case of international or interstate move. It will also help track the move of infected people and the people t hey interact with thereby helping in identification of people requiring home isolation or quarantine. Further it will inform people who have been tested if they are infected.

This app will also alert you if you have infected people nearby. You will be able to know if you are in proximity of infected people through bluetooth, even identify them. Necessary precautions can therefore be taken by you.

This app can be downloaded on android phones. Hopefully this app will help us in identifing infected people.
